

Teachers

Whenever homework is assigned it should be posted on the District Website. Using a homework bulletin board or electronic equivalent, teachers will coordinate and post student homework assignments so that multiple tests and/or large-scale projects are not due on the same day. After School “Guided Study” sessions are conducted throughout the school year so students have opportunities to complete homework and/or seek additional assistance.

Students

Beginning in 2nd grade, students should utilize a daily assignment notebook. In-school study time should be used wisely and students should seek help from teachers when needing further assistance or clarification. Students should notify teachers in advance if an assignment is incomplete. Students and parents should jointly develop a homework completion plan. All required homework assignments are expected to be completed if a student misses school. Individual homework completion plans maybe developed between the teacher and student due to extended illness or other similar circumstances.

Parents

In order that students achieve success in school, parents should help students develop a positive attitude about completing homework. Parents are encouraged to become partners with teachers, administrators, and their child(ren) in promoting homework as a part of his/her growth and development. Parents are encouraged to establish a consistent time and place to complete homework in a quiet and timely fashion.
