

Students are prohibited from using or possessing any electronic communication devices (ECDs) including, but not limited to, cell phones and pagers during the school day or at school sponsored activities that occur during the regular school day. ECD's may be brought to school by a student, but must remain in the student's locker and turned off until the end of the school day. The Board of Education recognizes that there may be special circumstances that necessitate student use of ECDs, such as a medical, educational, and/or family emergency. Therefore, students with the written consent of the District Administrator may be granted permission to possess and use ECDs

If the use, or possession of an ECD is granted the use may not, in any way:

- A. disrupt the educational process in the School District
- B. endanger the health or safety of the student or anyone else
- C. invade the rights of others at school
- D. involve illegal or prohibited conduct of any kind

The use of an ECD in any locker room or other area in which students dress is prohibited at all times.

Any student possessing an ECD shall be responsible for its care. At no time shall the District be responsible for preventing theft, loss or damage to any ECD.
