

All students enrolled in the Richmond School District must have on file one of the following:

1. Immunization records as required by state law. Except as otherwise provided, immunizations shall be required for chicken pox, measles, rubella, diphtheria, pertussis (whooping cough), poliomyelitis, tetanus, mumps, and Hepatitis B. Immunizations shall be paid for by the student's parent(s)/guardian, unless otherwise provided.
2. A written immunization waiver signed by the student's parent/guardian or legal custodian objecting to the immunization for reasons of health, religion or personal conviction.

The District Administrator/designee, shall be responsible for notifying the student's parent/guardian or student of the immunization requirements and informing such persons of the right to an immunization waiver. In addition, the District Administrator/designee shall be responsible for maintaining complete and current immunization records for each student attending school in the District.
