Student Scholarships and Awards

Policy #: 460

The Richmond School District Board of Education recognizes the importance of providing students with the best possible opportunities for educational success. The Student Awards program acknowledges student achievements in curricular, co-curricular, and extra-curricular pursuits and endeavors.

Richmond School District does not discriminate against pupils on the basis of the person's sex, race, national origin, ancestry, creed, religion, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation, or physical, mental, emotional, or learning disability or handicap as required by Statute 118.13 in its education programs or activities. The District also prohibits discrimination as defined by Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972 (sex), Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 (race and national origin), and Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established Board policies.
