

Richmond School Safety Plan

The Richmond School Safety Plan provides action plans and checklists for sixteen (16) different scenarios that can potentially impact the health and safety of students and staff. There are also sample letters and communication plans for each of the sixteen (16) scenarios. The safety plan was reviewed and approved by the board of education in August 2018 for compliance with Act 143. Over this summer, the Richmond School Safety Plan was updated to comply with the new regulations of Act 143.

In addition to the updated safety plan, there were several safety and security upgrades at Richmond over the summer. These updates include:

- security cameras throughout the building funded by the Department of Justice Safety Grant
- new outdoor key fob access system
- one-touch 911 notification system
- video camera entry system
- new PA system

The District is also conducting its second ALICE training for all staff prior to the start of the new school year.
