

RICHMOND DISTRICT GOALS 2018-19

Goal 1: The Richmond School District will continue to achieve academic excellence by creating a safe learning environment that develops the whole child and utilizing Personalized Learning (PL), as evidenced at the end of the 2018-2019 school year by:

1. A Wisconsin State Report Card Score of 90 or higher.

3. The number of families indicating on a parent survey that their child feels safe at school will increase from the previous year's results.

Goal 2: The Richmond School District will continue to build partnerships with families and community stakeholders to advance the quality education for our students as evidenced at the end of the 2018-2019 school year by:

1. Adding public or private partnerships to advance the educational mission of the District.
2. Increasing the overall satisfaction with the District on parent survey from the previous year.
3. A majority of parents indicating on the parent survey that the District increased family engagement practices from the previous school year.
